

Privacy Policy

How we store and use your personal data:

Studio 76 College and Academy, collect personal data as part of the application process – e.g. your name, address, telephone number and email address. We use your personal data only in connection with communicating with you via post and email.

Storage of personal data

Paper application forms are stored, by the Principal or Exams Officer if required. All paper documents containing personal data are stored securely on private property in a secure room with limited access. If you leave the College or Academy your personal details will be destroyed securely within 6 months.

Confidentiality

All current have signed an Acceptable Use and Confidentiality agreement which includes keeping passwords protected and their own personal computers and devices secure to prevent inadvertent or deliberate access to any personal data.

Processing your personal data

We usually email information to our Students, Pupils and Parents and we make every effort to hide email addresses from other members by use of the BCC (blind carbon copy) feature available through our email software.

The only other way we process any personal data is by post for those few who are not on email.

We do not share or sell your personal information to any third parties without your express permission.

Social Media

We use social media to promote events and to keep you informed of the activities of Studio 76 College and Academy. We do not store or process any personal data regarding your social media account(s) and we will rely on the privacy policies of the social media companies and/or your privacy settings when interacting with you online, for example, inviting you to join the closed Facebook group for Studio 76.

Cookies

The site uses non-essential cookies to analyse performance of this website and display content from other content providers such as social media feeds. These cookies are automatically disabled and you have to 'ACCEPT' them for the website to work as expected. You can enable them at a later date if you wish. Your web-browser settings can also be configured to ban cookies too giving you a greater level of confidentiality when using the internet.

Cookies collect anonymous information about your usage of the internet and can be used to profile adverts for you. In some cases Cookie information and other personal information could be cross-referenced and lead to you being identifiable which becomes personal data.
